2010 PAVING PROJECT

At the May 18 Board of Trustees' meeting, the Board voted to award a paving contract to Don Garcia Excavating and Paving. This year's paving includes Elks Point Rd. from Highway 50 to McFaul Way and McFaul Way from Elks Point Rd. to Kent Way. The scope of work for this project includes rebuilding the road and paving. During construction, minor delays will be unavoidable. The contractor has met with the Board of Trustees and understands the critical nature of this project. All efforts will be made to minimize disruptions during construction.

Construction is scheduled to commence during the week of July 12th. Traffic control will be an important consideration during construction. Please be patient while we improve the roads in Round Hill. We are excited about this project and welcome any feedback from residents. Please do not hesitate to call if you have questions or concerns.

ASIAN CLAM PILOT PROJECT:

The Asian Clam removal pilot project that occurred last summer showed some success. As a result, the plan is to expand the clam removal project for this summer to further analyze the success of the pilot. This year's project will consist of placing ½ acre of rubber barriers on the bottom of the Lake in Marla Bay and ½ acre near the Lakeside Marina. These bottom barriers will remain in place for approximately 90 days. Installation of the rubber bottom barriers in Marla Bay is scheduled to commence on July 8. Barges and other apparatus may be on the Lake during installation and removal of the barriers.
