**2010 Paving Project**

At the May 18 Board of Trustees' meeting, the Board voted to award a paving contract to Don Garcia Excavating and Paving. This year's paving includes Elks Point Rd. from Highway 50 to McFaul Way and McFaul Way from Elks Point Rd. to Kent Way. Construction is scheduled to commence after the July 4<sup>th</sup> holiday. Traffic control will be an important consideration during construction. Please be patient while we improve the roads in Round Hill.

**Fire Safe Chapter Update**

Property Owners are encouraged to comply with Defensible Space Guidelines ([livingwithfire.info](http://livingwithfire.info)). The first step is to remove all pine needles, cones, and other dead vegetation within 30 feet of the structure. The Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District "Compost Your Combustibles" program will allow pine needles, cones, and slash to be dropped off at Boulder Base from May 29<sup>th</sup> to July 11<sup>th</sup>.

Property Owners can obtain assistance for fuel removal this year through the Five Step Defensible Space Rebate Process ([nvfsc.org](http://nvfsc.org)) which will refund 50% of up to \$2000 spent with approved contractors.

The RHGID will fund a **pine needle pick-up on Thursday and Friday June 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>** this year. Bags of clean needles and cones should be placed at the curb. **Do not place bags next to your trash cans on Wednesday June 9<sup>th</sup>, as you may be charged extra.**

Let's all work together to make our neighborhood more fire safe!
